A TOP HEALTH CLINIC FOR THOSE WHO NEED IT MOST

CentroMed is a San Antonio-based nonprofit community health center that wanted to design a first-class \$12 million facility for the at-risk community in San Antonio's Indian Creek district. The local Southwest Side population was in urgent need of health resources; 31% are uninsured, and two-thirds live at or below the 200% poverty line. A Federally Qualified Health Center funded by both public and private funds, CentroMed's clinic includes a massive main workout area filled with 30 pieces of Precor cardio equipment in addition to an 800-sqft women's only workout area directly connected to the women's locker room. Of great benefit to members is the networked cardio's internet connectivity, so that not only can members engage with amazing entertainment features like Netflix and Hulu, but they can track their progress too. This main cardio theater room also includes numerous selectorized, plate loaded, and free weight lifting stations, all American-made Precor equipment.
